



Dear Swiss neighbours

For shippings into Switzerland are valid these rules:

1. You get a net invoice, this means without 19 % German VAT
2. The shipping costs into Switzerland amounts to 8.90 EUR (up to 2 kg; further see Dispatch table) and also 24.50 EUR customs administration fees

In our Shop we have to show all prices inclusive VAT.

Therefore we have inserted a discount for you (equivalent for "minus VAT."),
If you choose in the basket the delivery area "Switzerland" the price is automatically without VAT.

Thus your invoice sum is without VAT.

If you examine your purchase order form in the last step of order you will state that the price is with VAT. This is not correct.

But the invoice sum agrees with the price without VAT again and you can pay your order without any problem by credit card (recommended).

After the order and/or with the shipping you get a correct invoice (without VAT).

Here, we would like to give you a simple example:

< Beginning of the example >

You buy one (or several) item(s) in the value of 119 EUR.

19 EUR of it are German VAT. Thus you have to pay only 100 EUR.

Because of the discount your order looks like this in the basket:

Article	Quantity	Price per unit	Ger. VAT	Total price
x	1	119,00	19,00 (19 %)	119,00
Discount				-19,00
Shipping costs*				*33,40
Invoice amount				133,40
Contained VAT				21,30

* Shipping costs built themselves up as follows:

8,90 EUR Dispatch + 24,50 EUR customs administration fees.

The invoice amount of 133,40 EUR is already the net amount and applies.

The indicated VAT is not shown in the invoice you get later.

Alternatively:

Swiss who live next to the border (Schaffhausen) we have also a fetching address in Germany (Gottmadingen/ Singen).

In your order you select then „delivery area“ Germany.

We send your package to Gottmadingen and you fetch and pay it there.

In this case you have to pay the shipping costs for Germany and the invoice is also include german VAT.

These VAT can be refunded after import into Switzerland. With import into Switzerland you can ask at the tariff-office for stamping a certificate of export (you will get an appropriate form with the package). Then the stamped form you can send us back.
